MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PROPERTY OWNERS MEETING

QUORUM: Mr. Sebastian stated there more than 57 owners represented at the meeting in person and by proxy. He confirmed there were sufficient attendees and proxies to meet the quorum requirement. Official business can be conducted at this meeting.

OPENING: At 7:04 pm, Mr. Sebastian officially opened the meeting. He introduced himself as Property Manager for the Springbrook HOA and stated that ACMI is the management company hired to work with the association on administrative and financial affairs. The board members then introduced themselves. Mr. Sebastian then noted that the meeting will follow the distributed agenda (see attachments).

Two winners of \$100 Lowe's gift cards were selected at random from the attendees and received the gift cards.

SECURITY REPORT

Sergeant Cohen with the Pct. 4 Constable's Office introduced himself and gave a brief report regarding crime statistics from Springbrook in 2014. The annual statistics included 2 break-ins, 8 burglaries of motor vehicles, 1 theft of habitation, 7 vehicle thefts, 8 vehicle burglaries, 9 theft other, 26 suspicious vehicles reported, 16 suspicious persons, 9 criminal mischief, 4 assaults. Sgt. Cohen stated these numbers are too low and not allow crime is being reported. He encouraged all attendees to report crime to Pct. 4 and to always report suspicious activity of people.

He explained that Springbrook is included in the area patrolled by the Bridgestone MUD contract. The contract includes 8 officers and 3 more are being added in 2015.

Discussion topics included; locking vehicles and garages, reporting all suspicious activity, vacation check, and hiding valuables in vehicles. Sgt. Cohen reminded homeowners to call Pet. 4 dispatch directly for non-emergency issues at 281-376-3472. He also stated alarm companies should be given this number.

MANAGEMENT REPORT:

Mr. Sebastian discussed the attached financial handout.

- He reported the association continues to be in sound financial shape with \$270,651 in cash reserves at the end of 2014.
- Mr. Sebastian then reviewed the income statement and major expenses for 2014 and discussed the 2015 budget.
- Reserve funds will be reduced in 2015 to help cover the splash pad installation costs. A budget deficit of \$68,027 is projected for 2015.

Mr. Sebastian then reviewed the attached PowerPoint presentation. The need for a reserve fund was discussed.

He reported that the HOA board has been considering options to improve security within the community. He reported that board has discussed adding a Contract Officer dedicated to just Springbrook. The annual cost would be approximately \$119 per homeowner per year and the current budget does not allow for this large ongoing cost. The board is also considering options for security cameras at the entrances to the community. The board will be looking into the cameras further in 2015.

The splash pad was also discussed in detail. The board has approved proceeding with the splash pad with a target opening date of June 1, 2015. The splash pad installation cost and ongoing maintenance and operations costs were reviewed. Results from the online survey were also discussed with 60% approval for the splash pad among the 122 respondents. Some attendees suggested a gate around the splash pad. The board reported that there are no plans to install a gate or fence at the splash pad but may consider it in the future.

The trash collection service was discussed. Mr. Sebastian reported that the trash service is provided by Bridgestone MUD and the HOA was not involved with the decision to change providers. Homeowners should contact Republic Waste with specific questions about the new service. All homeowners are expected to keep their trash cans out of sight except on pick up days.

VOTING

Director Elections: Mr. Sebastian stated there are three positions to be filled at this meeting for two-year terms. The board duties were discussed.

Mr. Sebastian reported Ms. Meharali has removed her name from the running. Mr. Sebastian asked for any additional volunteers from the floor for the board to be a write-in candidate. There were three additional candidates in addition to the candidates already on the ballot.

The candidates were:

- Lindsey Magdaleno

Each candidate briefly introduced themselves and stated why they wanted to serve on the board.

Mr. Sebastian asked the homeowners to complete and submit their ballots and vote for only three candidates.

After tally the votes, the three candidates elected to the board were:

ADJOURN: Meeting was adjourned at 8:55pm.

- * The board conducted a SurveyMonkey.com survey to gather homeowner's feedback on the splash pad
- * Results:
 - * 122 unique responses (duplicates removed)
 - * 48 No's
 - * 74 Yes and Yes, plus comments
 - * 60% approval
- * Request for homeowners to take survey was communicated through email, Facebook, and mailed letters.
